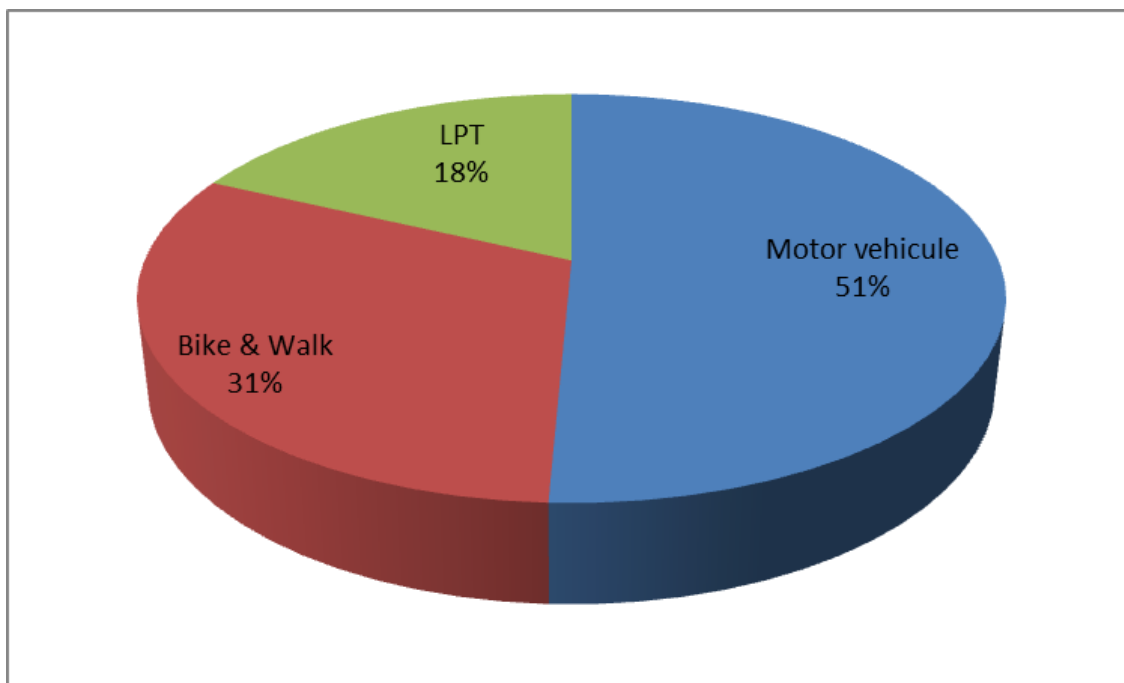

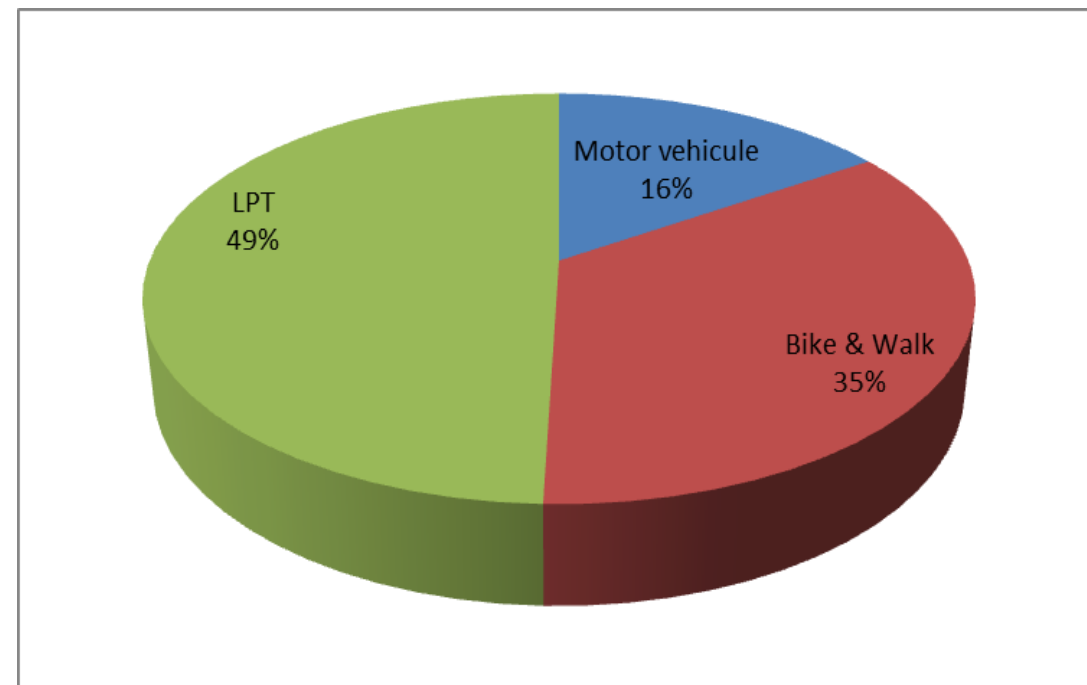
- Pavia: town with 70,000 inhabitants, 40 km south of Milan Lombardy, Italy

- Three important scientific hospitalization and academic care institutions

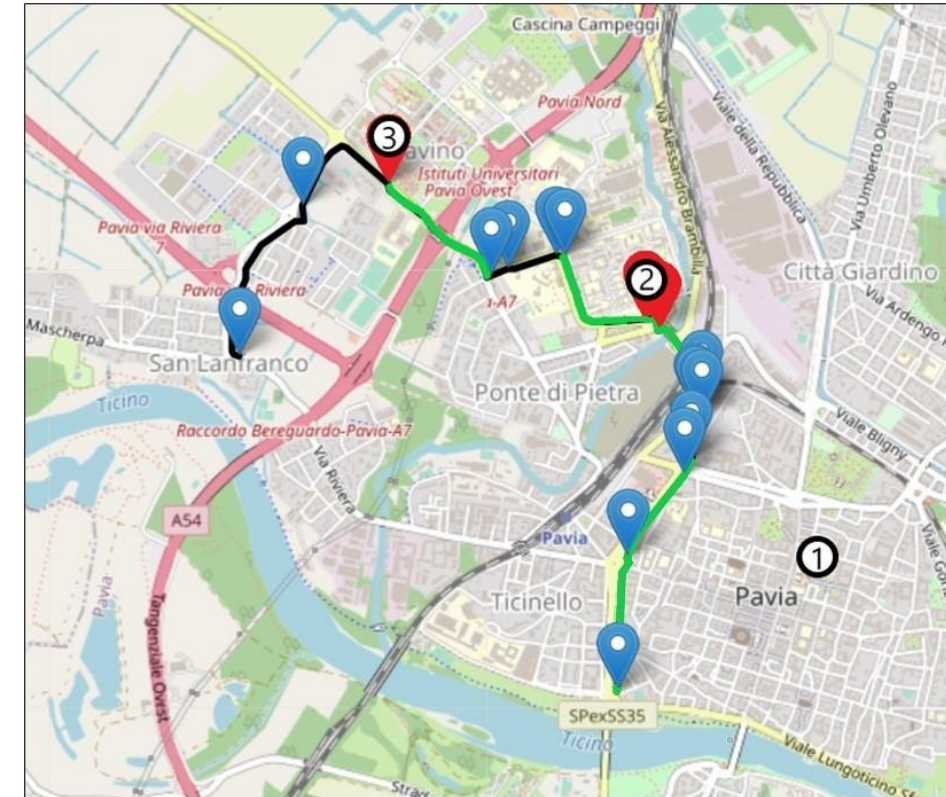
